

WHY I WANT TO BELIEVE THE BIBLE

It is a mistake to confuse the following two questions: "Why do you believe the Bible?" and "Why do you *want* to believe the Bible?" These two questions do not necessarily have the same answer. One may desire for something to be true, and yet it be false. One should believe the Bible because there is good evidence that the Bible is from God. One may *want* to believe the Bible for a host of other reasons.



George DeHoff, the respected gospel preacher of the 20th century, once wrote a sermon in which he listed a number of reasons why he wanted to believe the Bible. I reproduce these reasons here, with some comment:

- 1. I want to believe the Bible because it teaches that I will live after death. Life on Earth would be so bleak and discouraging if it carried no indication of continued, conscious existence after death. And yet, the Bible offers the promise that our brief, troubled earthly life is an introduction to our immortality (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18).
- 2. I want to believe the Bible because it teaches I will go to a better home than this one. Life on Earth has its disappointments, but one of the wonders of the Bible is that it portrays a perfectly satisfying destination for everyone who is right with God (1 Peter 1:3-5).

- 3. I want to believe the Bible because it teaches that I can meet again the loved ones who have gone before. Life on Earth is made sweeter by friendship with godly loved ones, but death separates us. The Bible portrays a glorious, unending reunion with them (Matthew 8:11; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18).
- 4. I want to believe the Bible because I have always been taught that it is true. Not everyone is taught the truthfulness of the Bible from childhood, but for those of us who were taught this, it would be a great disappointment to find out that our most cherished beliefs were false all along. On the other hand, it is thrilling to discover that the most exciting beliefs do, in fact, reflect reality.

Having reviewed these good reasons for wanting to believe the Bible, it is all the more marvelous to study the overwhelming evidence for the Bible's inspiration and recognize that the Bible *is* true! It is the inspired word of God, which can make us complete spiritually and save us from hell (2 Timothy 3:15-17). Caleb
