This choice violates at least the following three biblical principles: (1) The mandate to prioritize God's kingdom over all else (Matthew 6:33; 22:37-40; Romans 12:1-2). (2) The mandate to obey the eldership (Hebrews 13:17; 1 Thessalonians 5:12-13; 1 Timothy 5:17). The mandate to not forsake the assembly (Hebrews 10:25).

Gus Nichols was a beloved gospel preacher of the 20th century. He wrote a powerful poem on the subject of Sunday night attendance. The poem is called "But Not on Sunday Night," and is reproduced below.



I love the church that Jesus built,

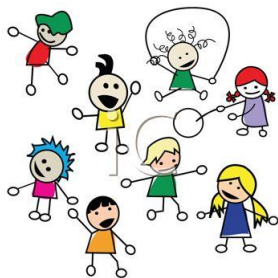

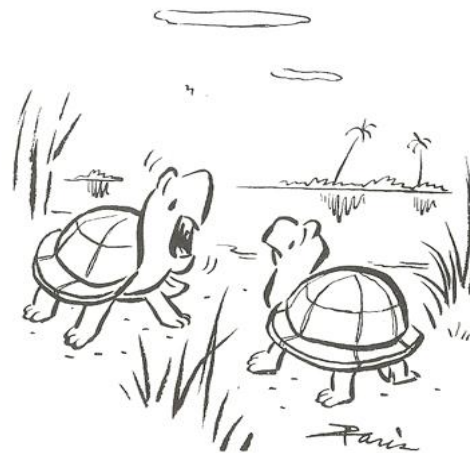
CONTACT GROUP
